



Restore the Guildhall

Our long running campaign to have the Brunner Guildhall refurbished and fully occupied once again, is progressing, but far too slowly.

Winsford Town Council (who own the Guildhall) is currently paying Cheshire West Council over £17,000 per year for their offices in Wyvern House. If the Town Council occupied part of the Guildhall, they would achieve a sizeable saving year on year of scarce resources.

Town Centre Redevelopment - Still Waiting for Action

The Liberal Democrat Campaign, which started in 2014, to persuade Cheshire West to buy back the Lease of the Town Centre and manage it themselves, has paid off.

In 2018 Cheshire West did buy back the Lease for just over £19 million. But four years were wasted, when we could have been developing a town centre we could all be proud of. Coincidentally with local elections looming, we have been promised that the Labour controlled Cheshire West Council will reveal their master plan for the future of the Town centre. No doubt there will be much talk of "widely consulting and carrying out surveys" etc. So don't expect anything to happen to our town centre much before 2021.
